RESISTA® ELMS ARE IDEAL TREES FOR STREETS AND PARKS AND HAVE EXCELLENT RESISTANCE TO DUTCH ELM DISEASE. WE SUPPLY THREE DISEASE-RESISTANT VARIETIES.

### RESISTA® elms are resistant to Dutch elm disease

Dutch elm disease has destroyed millions of trees. The highly-resistant RESISTA® elms were developed through extensive breeding work. They are propagated by means of cuttings, grown on their own roots and are not grafted. This ensures outstanding resistance to the fungal infection of Dutch elm disease. This resistance is regularly checked of tough infection tests with virulent pathogens. Cultivation on genuine roots also prevents stem breakage at the grafting point.

# RESISTA® elms are dependable

Within five years, the stem circumference grows from 14 to 16 cm to 40 cm or more. RESISTA® elms are extremely tolerant of urban conditions and can even establish themselves in hot inner city locations with dry air.



# RESISTA® Elms are low maintenance

Only slight corrections are required in the crown area. The leaves decompose quickly. In addition, RESISTA® elms do not grow any large fruit or produce honeydew.

#### RESISTA® elms are undemanding

These trees grow in soil that is poor in nutrients and humus, light and dry soils, as well as heavy, dense and poorly aerated soils. They also flourish in areas that are far from groundwater, in sealed areas and in thin soils on cliffs, rocks and gravel. Even then they develop with amazing vitality and are amazingly fast growing.

### RESISTA® elms cope well with traffic

Wind resistant, stable and extremely hardy to frost. The branches don't even break under the weight of heavy snowfall. Minor damage, for example, in the stem area, grows back very quickly.

#### RESISTA® elms are safe from forgery

We are one of the few specialist companies in Europe allowed to grow and market RESISTA® elms. Genuine RESISTA® elms can be clearly identified in three ways:

- A label on the tree showing the variety provides security with regard to the authenticity of the variety and quality.
- An authenticity certificate is attached to each delivery.
- An implanted transponder (microchip) secures each RESISTA® elm against variety falsification. A reading device can be used to prove authenticity at any time.

# RESISTA® Fiorente

- Single leader extending right to the top of the tree
- Narrow, pyramidal crown shape with a transparent, uncompacted structure
- Foliage is medium green and therefore slightly lighter than that on the New Horizon and Rebona varieties
- Retains its foliage for the longest of all the RESISTA® elms



#### RESISTA® Rebona

- Flatter branches than New Horizon elms
- Pyramid-shaped to wide-cone-shaped crown
- Smaller leaves than New Horizon, light, rough hairiness
- Young shoots and leaf stalks have a reddish colour on the upper side



#### RESISTA® New Horizon

- Initially grows in a pyramid to oval shape. As the tree gets older, the crown gets wider and rounder
- Very similar to the European elm
- Thick, very green foliage
- Silky, shiny, dark-green leaves, irregular leaf margin, double serration



# RESISTA® Regal

- Head branch formation goes right through to the top
- Relatively narrow and transparent crown due to upright-growing branches
- Somewhat looser, lighter foliage
- Narrower leaves than New Horizon and Rebona
- Leaves turn an attractive yellow colour in autumn
